8 ¶ And Israel beheld Joseph's sons, and said. Who are these? 9 And Joseph said unto his father, They are my sons, whom God hath given me in this place. And he said, Bring them, I pray thee, unto me, and I will bless them. 10 Now the eyes of Israel were dim for age, so that he could not see. And he brought them near unto him; and he kissed them, and embraced them, 11 And Israel said unto Joseph. Genesis 49:1 - 49:20
