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Every place you look in scripture there are nuggets more valuable than anything you'd take to an assayer. Dig out rich lessons to be learned, in 'shunned scripture' like Jewish family trees etc. Let's dig some together...right now.

Turn to the second chapter of the Old Testament book of Numbers. Hey! This was inspired by God too!

Here we'll see the numbers of the 12 tribes and their totals and subtotals. Remember that the word "score" equals 20. We see here, to total of each tribe written grammatically. Example: Total of Reuben's tribe was 46500 (verse 11) Next fill in that number in the right place of the puzzle list. Repeat those steps for all 12 tribes listed in chapter 2. Then keep the aspirin bottle handy as you search for the key numbers in the puzzle.

Now the frosting on the cake; the nugget is in verse 32. The point is that as Moses penned the book of Numbers, he had bad-hair days just like you and I. If he had written the book without God's inspiration, I bet the numbers wouldn't add up right and therefore match the total. Wouldn't Satan have a field day with that?!

So the real nugget here, is that God and His protective hand is everywhere His servants are trying to do their best for Him -- even through those bad-hair days.

Notice the corresponding counts in chapter 1. Their subtotals (North, South, East, & West) all add up to verse 32 AND ALSO chapter 1 grand total in verse 46. We can depend on the accuracy of scripture, even in 'boring' numbers of the book of Numbers. I love the Old Testament.

Share the puzzle with others, and remind them that Jesus would still have shed His blood on the Cross for each one. He did that because He knows how wonderful Heaven is, and how indescribably terrible Hell is. Reach out to those around you, and get them into Heavens book of Life and Love. {end}
